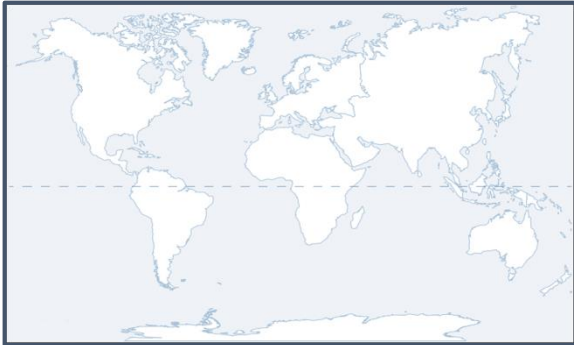


Year 2 Geography

Around the World



In this unit, children will learn the 7 continents. They will learn about where they are located and they will look at each continent in-depth and will be able to name landmarks, features and different facts about them. To apply this knowledge, children will then do a short piece of writing saying which continent they would most and least like to visit and why.

1	Children will learn about the 7 continents of the world and will be able to locate them on a world map.
2	Children will learn about what Europe is like.
3	Children will learn about what Australasia is like.
4	Children will learn about what Asia is like.
5	Children will learn about what Africa is like.
6	Children will learn about what North America is like.
7	Children will learn about what South America is like.
8	Children will learn about what Antarctica is like.
9	Children will write about which continent they would most like to visit and why.

The Oceans



In this unit, children will learn the names and locations of the 5 oceans, identifying where they are using a globe and a map and comparing and ordering them by size. They will learn about why the oceans are important and how they are under threat.

1	Children will learn the names of the 5 oceans and be able to locate them on a globe.
2	Children will learn the names of the 5 oceans and be able to locate them on a world map
3	Children will embed their knowledge of the 5 oceans and order them from biggest to smallest.
4	Children will learn about why the oceans are important.
5	Children will learn about how oceans are under threat.

Investigating Weather



Children will begin this unit by recapping their knowledge, identifying weather and seasons. Children will use a weather station to record the weather, including wind, rain and temperature. Using weather pictograms children will compare the weather between coastal and inland areas. They will also learn about hot and cold areas around the world, discussing which type of area they would prefer to visit and why.

1	Children will recap weather learnt in Year 1 – identifying weather and seasons.
2	Children will investigate weather in coastal areas compared to inland.
3	Children will learn about hot and cold areas around the world.
